**Course: English (Compulsory)**

The expected course outcome of teaching English in B.A. programme is as follows:

1. The course trains students to comprehend the nuances of the different genres of literature. Students get acquainted with five prominent genres of literature i.e. essay, short-story, poetry, drama and fiction (one literary genre each semester).
2. The grammatical aspects of language are systematically imparted to learners with an imperative to enhance their communication skills.
3. Study of phonetic sounds, stress/accents and intonation enriches the linguistic aspects and complements the spoken English.
4. Students become well-versed with different narrative techniques, poetic tools and literary jargon.
5. It is expected that, by the end of the course, the learners acquire a huge vocabulary base which helps them in everyday conversation.
6. Composition skills such as paragraph writing, letter writing and dialogue writing are taught with an objective to train students for everyday correspondence.
7. A special emphasis on translation (English to Hindi and vice versa) is given in curriculum keeping in mind the prospects of jobs for bilingual/multilingual learners.
8. E-mail, RTI, Memo and Circulars are also given due consideration in course design so as to prepare learners for their impending professional life.
9. The component of literature instills the skill of creative writing among some learners.
10. Students become familiar with representative literary and cultural texts within a significant number of historical, geographical, and cultural contexts.
11. The Course educates students in both the artistry and utility of the English language through the study of literature and other contemporary forms of culture.
12. It assists students in the development of intellectual flexibility, creativity, and cultural literacy so that they may engage in life-long learning.
13. Above all, literature aims to sensitize learners with ethical values and humanitarian way of life; which is the primary objective of all courses/programmes pertaining to arts and humanities.
